Call to Order: Tim Cahill

Invocation: Jeff Cockrell

Tim led the discussion of the proposed 2022 SCFOA Budget with a presentation of it by screen sharing on Zoom.

Tim made a motion on behalf of the budget committee that the proposed be adopted.  
Ricky Robinson seconded the motion.

Keith Hajnal asked for an explanation on proposed income and expenses for 2022.

Tim Cahill explained that the Hall of Fame expenses were unusually large this year, due to three classes being inducted. The SCFOA account actually increased its income by \$1,500 through income from the Hall of Fame banquet being more than expenses.

Keith Hajnal also expressed a few of the members of his district are not in favor of renting a hotel room for state finals officials for games played at Benedict College Stadium.

Tim explained that splitting the late exam fees with the SCHSL is justified. The SCHSL incurs expenses for Board meetings that are not reimbursed.

Doug Hudson said the Athletic Director at Benedict College wants approval from the SCHSL for SCFOA to rent a Hospitality Room for officials at their stadium.

**Motion by Brian Hilpisch, second by Brad Smith** to add a line item of \$600.00 for hats for the state finals chain crews. **Approved, 15 yea, 0 nay**

**Motion by Brian Hilpisch, second by Ricky Robinson** to add a \$1,000.00 scholarship for a current SCFOA member who is pursuing higher education. The scholarship committee will determine the guidelines for eligibility. This would be proposed as a line item in the 2023 SCFOA Budget. **Approved, 15 yea, 0 nay**

Keith Hajnal questioned whether the budget should be approved with *TBA* listed for the line item *Hospitality and suite at State Finals*.

**Motion by Doug Hudson, second by Keith Hajnal** to remove the line item *Hospitality and suite at State Finals* from the 2022 budget, with the suggestion that the Executive Committee contact Benedict College to determine the cost and provide that amount to the Board for approval at a later date. **Approved 15 yea, 0 nay**

**Motion by Doug Hudson, second by Ricky Robinson** to change the line item for *state finals* to \$2,500.00. **Approved 15 yea, 0 nay**

Tim Cahill asked if there was any further discussion concerning the proposed budget. There was none.

**Motion by Todd Johnson, second by Doug Hudson** to adopt the 2022 SCFOA Budget with the changes above. **Approved 15 yea, 0 nay**

**Motion to adjourn by Doug Hudson, second by Darryl Jackson.**
